1. Background

Nexus Multi Academy Trust is medium sized Trust with ten open academies across South Yorkshire and a Free School in pre-opening.

Nexus MAT is a truly forward thinking Trust. The Trust was formed in 2016, has formulated a mission statement, clearly stating its values, and has a concise vision with a limited number of key priorities.

The vision for Nexus is that we are constantly "Learning together, to be the best we can be."

This vision is what we aspire for and is as relatable to every employee and partner of our Trust as it is to our children, young adults and their families.

In order to achieve our vision, we have the following mission statement:

2. Introduction

The Trust currently consists of ten open academes:

- Abbey School, Little Common Lane, Rotherham
- Bader School, Edenthorpe, Doncaster
- Becton Hospital School, Sevenairs Road, Sheffield
- Coppice School, Ash Hill Road, Doncaster
- Crags Community School, Strauss Crescent, Rotherham
- Heatherwood School, Ledger Way, Doncaster
- Hilltop School, Larch Road, Rotherham
- Kelford School, Oakdale Road, Rotherham
- North Ridge School, Tenter Balk Lane, Doncaster
- Pennine View, Old Road, Doncaster

We currently employ 846 staff across the nine schools and the Central Trust Team.

This procurement will also cover the following:

Nexus Multi Academy Trust has won the right to open two new special schools. The first opened in Doncaster on 1 September 2020. The second that the Trust has been granted permission to open is an 80-place special free school for children with autism spectrum disorder and social, emotional, and mental health needs in Sheffield from 1 September 2021.

The final service will cover all eleven academies and the central Trust team for internal audit services as detailed in this specification.

We anticipate that all academies will move to the new arrangements from 1st February 2021 (with the Sheffield free school joining in September 2021), but we reserve the right to vary membership and timings to reflect circumstances. For the duration of this contract, we may further grow the Trust. We will let this contract on the basis that other schools can be added on (at least) the same terms.



3. Requirements

We are seeking to procure a service that provides:

Internal Audit Services

The Trust requirements are as follows:

- Independent checking of financial controls, systems, transactions and risks to be undertaken 3 times per year, preferably in February, April and June.
- Work with the Trust Board, specifically the Audit & Risk Committee to devise and operate an internal audit work programme, focussing on specific areas of activity /risk.
- Issuing an Internal Audit Assurance Report to the Chair of the Audit and Risk Committee, detailing areas tested, results of those tests and recommendations and the level of risk that each point carries.
- Ad-hoc advice and guidance on new and emerging changes to financial reporting requirements and changes to the AFH.
- A working knowledge of the Access (HCSS) financial management system.

Nexus MAT will endeavour to answer all written enquiries prior to tenders been submitted and reserves the right not to respond to a request for information or clarification.

All tenders are required to be submitted by the date quoted in the table 20th November 2020. It is the responsibility of the tenderer to ensure that the tender is submitted and delivered on time. The Trust will not consider late or incomplete submissions. The submission should be via email to gbailey@nexusmat.org although tenderers may also submit paper copies of any documents to the Purchase to Pay Officer, Magna 34 Business Park, A06 1st Floor, Temple Road, Rotherham, S60 1FG.

The Trust will shortlist tenders and then invite providers to a formal interview. The Trust reserves the right to vary the timetable, and is also under no obligation to appoint a preferred bidder from this exercise.

5. Submission of Tender

All tenders should specifically identify:

- A total annual cost proposal;
- A clear indication of services provided as part of the fee;
- The variable costs for the proposal, including charge per new academy / ad-hoc advice, if applicable;
- Any inflationary or other provisions for periodic increase in fees;
- Fees chargeable for additional services that are not included in as part of the annual cost proposal;
- Your firms approach to client management and how you offer ongoing support.
- Evidence of working with Multi Academy Trusts and/or charitable trusts
- Evidence of working with Access (HCSS) Budgeting and Accounting software.
- Example Internal Audit plan
- Statistics on Client Retention and Recruitment rates.
- Biographies of staff the Trust will be working with, listing expertise and experience.
- The reports available to the Trust;
- Two References from organisations that you have worked with within the educational sector
- Compliance measures for meeting the requirements of the Data Protection Act 2018;



- A brief description of your business continuity plans that mitigate against an interrupted service should this arise;
- Confirmation that you will carry out code of conduct of the professional body;
- What "added value" you can offer Nexus Multi Academy Trust.

Tenderers should be aware that questions that arise during the tendering process, together with answers, will be circulated to all potential bidders who have expressed an interest in the procurement.

6. Contracting and Invoicing

The contract will be for a three-year period, commencing on 1st February 2021, unless terminated in accordance within the terms of the contract.

The Trust is under no obligation to appoint a provider from this exercise and reserves the right not to appoint or to re-run the exercise. The Trust will not be liable for any costs prior to appointment, including submission of Tender.

Invoices should be sent to Nexus Multi Academy Trust and should clearly state the purchase order number.

7. Instructions to Tenderers

Please submit your tender offer in accordance with all of the instructions, requirements and specification.

Please ensure your proposal is no longer than 10 pages or up to 15 slides.

All tenders must be complete and submitted to gbailey@nexusmat.org by the specified deadline.

8. Compliance

Nexus Multi Academy Trust reserves the right to disqualify or reduce the evaluation score of any tenderers who do not fully comply with the requirements in the tender documentation, in particular the closing date and time.



The Trust reserves the right to evaluate proposals on a variety of criteria. The tender with the lowest price will not automatically be accepted as the successful bid.

9. Termination

Either party may terminate the contract by giving 6 months' notice.

The initial period of the contract is three years; this could be renewed for an additional one or two year.

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
