We've had some recent appointments to key leadership roles in our academies: **Viki Drew** has been appointed as Deputy Headteacher at Kelford for the 2017/18 academic year, and **Chris Hodgkinson** has been permanently appointed as Deputy Head at Hilltop School. **Big congratulations** to both—they bring real strength and quality to the wider Nexus leadership team.

I'm really proud to report that a **national accolade for quality has been awarded to Kelford School** for its work in developing pupils learning, behaviour, well-being and self-esteem. The Quality Lead Award has been developed by leading education charity Achievement for All (AfA), and recognises the impressive work being done by the school to improve progress in reading, writing and maths for all pupils. Well done to Jacky, her team and all of our children at Kelford!



We've secured some amazing investment in our Trust recently, with £870,000 of Condition Improvement Funding being secured from the Education & Skills Funding Agency. This is a huge amount of capital investment for our most dilapidated academies, and is in large part down to the hard work of our CFO Tracey Brooke and our partners at E3 Cubed. What a difference this will make!

We're also providing more investment as a MAT into our academies, as we will be funding new, faster broadband to help with educational delivery in all our schools from September 2017!



Finally: all of our Rotherham academies were awarded the "Regional enterprise business award" on 9th May for our work with the RMBC coordinated "enterprise advisor" initiative. It's great to see the fruits of such investment in multi agency working, and I'm delighted we've had this recognized.
